



What should be in my bag? - Information Pack

When your child first starts nursery it can be confusing knowing what to pack in their bag each day.

Everyday can be different, and whilst you want to be prepared, we understand you don't want to have to pack everything but the kitchen sink!

At Little Legends we have created this handy leaflet to guide you through the process to ensure your child has the necessary items they will need during their day with us.

As your child grows from a baby into a pre-schooler some of the items will change. Also, as the seasons change you will need to provide appropriate extra items.

This guide makes helpful suggestions.

We strongly recommend that you label all of your child's belongings and use a zipped bag, to keep them in.

We remind you that the nursery cannot accept liability for items that may become lost or damaged at nursery.

Every child's bag should contain the following as a minimum:

- One full set of spare clothes, (although we recommend maybe 2 sets!) including, trousers , dress or skirt, spare t-shirt, spare jumper or cardigan.
- Spare underwear or baby vests
- Spare socks or tights (or both)
- Spare shoes

In the winter you will need to additionally provide:

- A warm winter coat or padded snow suit
- Wellingtons or waterproof boots and extra socks
- Gloves , hat and scarf

In the summer you will need to additionally provide:

- Summer jacket
- Sunhat (ideally that covers the neck)
- Sun cream (labelled with your child's name)

Babies and Tweenies

- Nappies - Please speak to your room leader for more details.
- Dummies
- Comfort toy or blanket

Toddlers and Pre-schoolers (especially when toilet training)

- Extra underwear
- Extra socks
- Extra change of clothes

Appropriate clothing and footwear

We ask that your child is dressed appropriately for the time of year and the weather conditions, for example a nice warm jumper if it is cold, and a cooler t-shirt if it is warm.

We ask that you do not dress your children in expensive or new clothes that may cause upset if lost or damaged. We remind you that the nursery cannot accept liability for children's personal belongings.

We also ask that children wear appropriate footwear, that fits - we appreciate children's feet can grow very quickly and is safe (flip flops and party shoes with heels can be tricky at nursery!)
